Crimson Joy PP# 31,194 - Yellow flesh, melting, freestone, firm, round, nearly full blushed. Medium to large fruit. Ripens 25 days before Elberta.

Liberty Joy PP# 31,109 - Yellow flesh, melting, freestone. Red blush yellow ground color. Productive, medium to large fruit. Pleasant eating quality. Ripens 16 days before Elberta.

Rich Joy PP# 31,081 - Yellow flesh, melting, freestone, firm rich flavor. Vigorous and productive. Yellow ground color with red blush color. Very large when adequately thinned. Ripens 2 days before Elberta.

May Joy PP# 35,118 - 650 chill hours, yellow flesh, cling, melting and firm, small to medium size. It's almost full blush. Always very round and appears not to have the prolong tip issue. Ripens 71 days before Elberta in Byron, GA.

Cardinal Joy PP# 35,114 850 chill hours, yellow flesh, semi-free, melting firm, almost full blush. Vary in shape (round to oblong). Ripens 57 days before Elberta in Byron, GA.

‡ August Rose™ (NJ356cltv) PP# 23,884 - August Rose is an attractive late season white - fleshed peach. The freestone fruit is very firm and has a delicious melting texture. This tree is tolerant to bacterial leaf spot and constriction canker. 60-90 percent red over cream color. 2 3/4 to 3 inch.

‡ July Rose™ (NJ354cltv) PP# 23,669 - July Rose is an unusual white - fleshed peach that vigorously produces large fruit 5-7 days before Redhaven. The firm fruit has a nice, sweet flavor with a very attractive red color, Tree is vigorous and productive and tolerant of bacterial leaf spot.

September Rose (NJ 362cltv) PP# 35,394 – Is a very attractive, late season, white freestone peach. Ripens 8 days after Elberta, large fruit, sweet flavor similar to August Rose. Higher tolerance to bacterial spot than other varieties in its season. Cold hardy. 800 chill hours.

‡ Felicia™ (NJ361cltv) PP#33,474- Yellow flesh, very productive. It's beautiful solid color with some red flesh. It's resistant to bacterial spot. Cold Hardy. 850 chill hours. Ripens 26 days before Elberta.

Effie is a new white-fleshed, mid-acid nectarine. It has a *very* firm, crisp texture and good storage potential. Non-melting flesh. Effie is intended for fresh market use.

‡ Silver GemTM (NJN100cltv) PP# 18,147 - This nectarine is medium in size with excellent color and firmness. The fruit is 80 percent red with cream-colored background and a pleasant balance of sugars and acid.

‡ AvalonTM (NJN101cltv) PP# 23,882 - This very early nectarine has a great combination of rich color, good flavor and high productivity compared to other varieties in its season. The fruit is firm with very sweet, but acid flavor. The trees are vigorous with low susceptibility to bacterial leaf spot.

BrigantineTM (NJN102cltv) PP# 30,125 - Yellow fleshed semi-freestone, ripens about 30 days before Elberta. Very productive tree with some resistance to bacterial spot. Fruit is consistently free from blemishes.

Ozark Mango - Orange-yellow flesh. 68% blush, good finish. Good bacterial spot resistance but not immunity'. 850 chill hours. Ripens 39 days before Elberta.

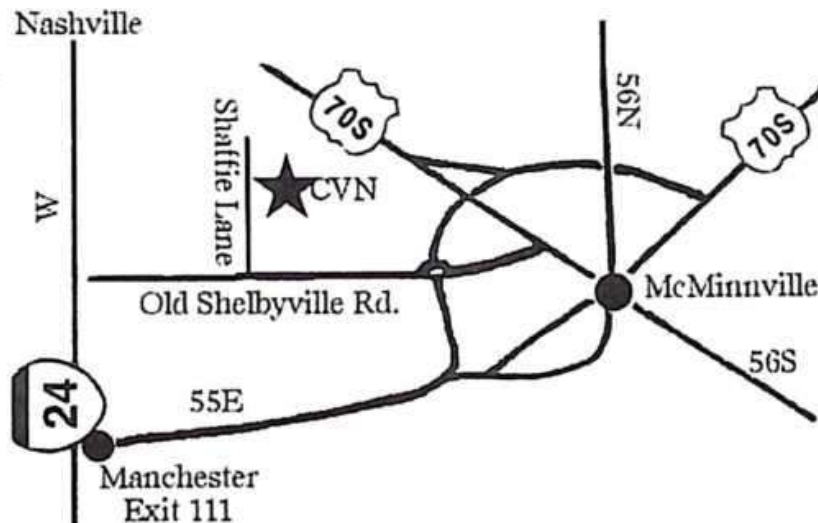

MINIMUM ORDER \$100.00

Orders \$100 net cash with order. One-half (*2) advance deposit is required on orders above \$100.00, with balance due before shipment, unless other arrangements have been approved. Orders that consist of fewer than 10 per variety will be charged at the 1-19 rate charge regardless of total number ordered. Shipping methods include UPS for smaller orders. Shipping cost and a box(s) charge will be added to the cost of the trees for UPS orders. Motor freight shipments will be sent collect and will travel at the risk of purchaser. Truckload shipments going to commercial areas, collect charges will be prorated on all combination loads, according to space, rather than weight. **Additional Shipping and Handling Fee will be added to boxes over 48 inches in length. Larger** size trees may have tops cut back before shipping — due to UPS restrictions.

Any order not paid for according to terms agreed on, will be subject to a late payment charge of 1 1/2 % per month, (which is a true annual rate of 18%).

Orders are accepted subject to prior sale of trees, crop hazards or loss from a cause over which we have no control. We exercise the greatest of care to keep varieties true to name as labeled, and will replace upon proper proof, any stock that may prove otherwise without charge. But it is mutually agreed that we shall not be liable for any amount greater than the purchase price paid to us.

We guarantee to ship good quality, well grown trees in good condition. Failure may result from improper planting, lack of moisture, frost, over-fertilization, etc., and we cannot guarantee continued growth after trees are planted on customers premises, as this is entirely beyond our control.

We exercise great care to deliver quality nursery stock. We give no warranty as to life, description, variety, quality productiveness, or any other matter whatsoever, of any nursery stock that we sell. We are not responsible for delay in shipment, or damage to stock from any cause after we turn the shipment over to the common carriers.

When you receive your order - notify us immediately if there are any trees in bad condition.

Shipping and handling charges are subject to change without notice.

Valuable Instructions

If your trees arrive in cold, freezing weather, follow these instructions.

1. DO NOT OPEN Shipment Immediately.
2. Place in a cool place, cellar or non-heated building, where the temperature is above freezing.
3. If possible, cover bale or box with tarpaulin, sawdust or any other material that will exclude air.
4. Allow trees to remain until ALL frost is out of container. A week or 10 days is not too long, trees will keep safely even longer.
5. AFTER ALL FROST IS OUT, trees may be unpacked and planted (if ground is not frozen), healed in or stored, keeping roots damp until planted.

If you will follow the above instructions, your tree life will greatly improve.

If possible, trees should be planted immediately after arrival from nursery. Roots should be kept covered to prevent drying out. In planting, set the tree upright in center of hole, spread roots evenly and work fine dirt in. DO NOT apply commercial fertilizer or manure to roots when planting. Any material of this type should be placed on top of soil after trees start to grow. We suggest watering trees when planted. Plant tree no more than one or two inches deeper than they were grown in nursery.

If it is impossible to plant trees immediately, heal them in. To do this, dig a trench, shovel width and depth, long enough to hold the roots when placed side by side in an upright position. Cover roots with fine soil until one-half full, soak with water, then pile remainder of soil around trees. As soon as weather permits, take trees up and plant permanently.

Contact your County' Agricultural Extension Agent for advice on varieties suited for your area; also best planting site.

Cumberland Valley Nurseries, Inc. will not be liable for nor warrant against, either express or implied, crop hazards or loss from a cause over which it has no control, including but not limited to improper planting or cultivation, lack of moisture, frost or freeze, overfertilization, excessive moisture, and any acts which under the laws of the State of Tennessee are considered acts of God.

3. Cumberland Valley Nurseries, Inc. warrants that if a court of proper jurisdiction determines that any sale is controlled by law other than the State of Tennessee that not less than seven percent (7%) of the fruit trees sold to a commercial grower, will conform to the variety, rootstock and interstem stated on the bill of lading and/or invoice, however, should there be more than seven percent (7%) of the trees described in the bill of lading and/or invoice mislabeled then the parties agree that the damage sustained by the purchaser shall be limited to the price that was paid by the buyer to the seller for the trees actually not meeting the variety, rootstock, or interstem stated on the bill of lading or invoice.

Should there be more than twenty-five percent (25 %) of the trees that do not conform to the variety, rootstock, or interstem stated on the bill of lading and/or invoice, then the damages that the seller, Cumberland Valley Nurseries, Inc. will pay to the purchaser, will be the full amount which the purchaser paid to the seller for the trees set out in the bill of lading and/or invoice.

4. In consideration of the order(s) being accepted, filled, shipped or picked up at Cumberland Valley Nurseries, Inc., the purchaser hereby expressly waives applicable provisions of law of any state in which the plants, fruit trees, nursery stock or horticultural products described in the bill of lading and/or invoice is/are to be grown, relative to varieties and warranties of fruit trees, nursery stock, and horticultural products and acknowledge and agree that the laws of the State of Tennessee will govern and control the sale and shipment of said products whether they be for home use or commercial orchard purposes.

5. This warrant}' does not cover consequential damages, and the liability of the seller is limited to replacing any trees which do not conform to the variety, root stock, and interstem stated on the bill of lading and/or invoice in accordance with the stipulations contained in this warranty. No other warranty, expressed or implied, is made.
